Schools/Proposition 39 Assistance Program

- Submitted six Energy Expenditure Plans (EEPs) for local educational agencies (LEAs) in Santa Clara County
 - 1,290,652 estimated kWh savings/year
- Three EEPs in development
- Partnership with Energize Schools
- No cost support services, including:
 - Benchmarking
 - Energy audits and identification of measures
 - Energy expenditure plan (EEP) submittal
 - Project implementation assistance
 - Reporting assistance
